WHAT IS FRIENDS FOREVER INTERNATIONAL?

OUR MISSION

Friends Forever International (FFI) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit that helps youth become the best versions of themselves so they can help their community become the best version of itself.

OUR HISTORY

The first delegation of youth leaders, made up of Catholic and Protestant younth from Northern Ireland, traveled to New Hampshire in 1986 during the height of The Troubles. The experience took them out of the conflict and into a neutral space. It allowed the youth to recognize their similarities rather than their differences, learn to work with each other instead of against, and return home with the skillsets to continue breaking these barriers. For many years, FFI was engaged primarily in the practice of intergroup contact theory. More recently, FFI has evolved its understanding of conflict transformation beyond the status quo of traditional conflict resolution programs into one that emphasizes individual leadership and community-level action. As an organization, we have grown to be a global organization with campuses and leadership programs on multiple continents.

OUR PRESENT

FFI now enrolls hundreds of leaders each year from the United States, as well as Northern Ireland, Ireland Uganda, Eastern Europe, and Central Asia. Participants come in groups from their schools or afterschool programs, or as individuals. All accepted applicants that apply individually receive a 100% full scholarship. This includes, travel expenses and all program fees. Additionally, all youth from NH receive academic credit for completing an FFI program.

To accommodate our programs' growth, FFI has established campuses in strategic locations. Our Global Hubs include the Office and Farmhouse in Durham, NH, the 70-bed FFI Center at Annalong, Northern Ireland, and our 30-acre Rainforest Academy in Belize.

What does each activity entail and what does your sponsorship support?

Van Ride

Spending time traveling in the van to activities is essential for team bonding and **playfulness**. Your support will cover the cost of fueling the van.

Family Style Dinner

Teams enjoy a plant-based dinner together as a family each night, often cooked by them to learn healthy habits. Your support will cover the cost of food and ingredients.

Memory Curriculum Books

Participants are given a tailored curriculum book that guides them through each activity, daily reflections, and journaling. Your support will cover the cost of materials.

Hike in the White Mountains

Each team completes a hike to challenge the participants and bond amongst a shared **effort**. Your support will cover the cost of the travel and hiking supplies.

Core Curriculum Workshops

FFI's core curriculum includes workshops to enhance participants' skills, such as **communication**, public speaking, mindfulness, art, and goal setting. Your support will cover the cost of facilitators and supplies.

Ropes Course

Each team completes a ropes course on their first day together in-person to build trust and **resilience**. Your support will cover the cost of the course.

Team Identity/Gear

The team creates a shared identity to unite them by designing a team logo, slogan, and name that FFI puts on their customized gear, such as t-shirts. Your support will cover the cost of the gear.

Boston Day

As part of FFI's cultural curriculum, participants travel to Boston to learn about its history and social services. Your support will cover the cost of the travel, food, and activites.

Volunteer Service Day

Each team completes several service projects to have a positive **impact** on the community and learn **empathy** for others'. Your support will cover the costs of materials needed for the projects.

Scholarship for Credit-Bearing Program

Through the NH Dept. of Education's Learn Everywhere Program, FFI can now grant high school credit to NH students through out programs. Your support will cover a full scholarship for a student to participate in our Credit-Bearing Programs.
