Join the Journey: FFI's Credit-Bearing Program

We are thrilled to announce an exciting development at Friends Forever International; the launch of our Credit-Bearing program under the NHDOE Learn Everywhere Initiative. This initiative allows us to provide students with unique and immersive educational experiences while earning academic credits. Today, we want to introduce you to three of our summer courses that offer a glimpse into the transformative power of this program.

Science-focused Program (July 1st - 8th): Participants will delve into the wonders of the NH Coastal Biome and earn a credit in Biological Sciences. Students from diverse backgrounds will form two teams, learning about the flora and fauna of this beautiful region while honing their communication and public speaking skills.

Adventure Educationfocused Program (July 9th - 16th): Participants will embark on an adrenalinefilled journey that combines outdoor activities like climbing, bouldering, and hiking. Throughout this course, participants will develop essential skills such as teamwork, problemsolving, and resilience.



Holistic & Mindful Living Program (August 5th - 12th): Participants will dive into the world of holistic well-being and mindfulness while earning credits in Health, English, and Team Building. This course will introduce students to the power of expressive arts therapy and teach valuable team-building skills.



The knowledge gained during each of their programs can be transferred as 2 credits to their high school transcript.

FFI can now deliver over 40 credits to New Hampshire high school students, making us the largest in-person out-of-school provider in the nation.

We believe that education extends beyond the classroom, and our credit-bearing program is a testament to that belief. By participating in these courses, students not only gain valuable academic credits but also develop crucial life skills such as resilience, empathy, communication, and impact. We are committed to providing innovative and impactful educational experiences that prepare students for success in an everchanging world.

Together, let's pave the way for a generation of empowered and resilient learners.


Get Inspired by the Summer Nationwide Team: Join Us in Making a Difference!


Sofia (Canada)
